Col. 3:11 Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.

Eph. 4:2 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

Col. 3:12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

Eph. 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Col. 3:13 Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Eph. 5:19 speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord,

Col. 3:16 Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

Eph. 5:20 always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Col. 3:17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Eph. 5:22 Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord.

Col. 3:18 Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

Eph. 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her

Col. 3:19 Husbands, love your wives and do not be harsh with them.

Eph. 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

Col. 3:20 Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.

Eph. 6:4 Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

Col. 3:21 Fathers, do not embitter your children, or they will become discouraged.

Eph. 6:5 Slaves, obey your earthly masters with respect and fear, and with sincerity of heart, just as you would obey Christ.

Col. 3:22 Slaves, obey your earthly masters in everything; and do it, not only when their eye is on you and to curry their favor, but with sincerity of heart and reverence for the Lord.

Eph. 6:7 Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not people,

Col. 3:23 Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters,

Eph. 6:8 because you know that the Lord will reward each one for whatever good they do, whether they are slave or free.

Col. 3:24 since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

Eph. 6:9 And masters, treat your slaves in the same way. Do not threaten them, since you know that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no favoritism with him.

Col. 4:1 Masters, provide your slaves with what is right and fair, because you know that you also have a Master in heaven.

Eph. 6:19,20 Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, <sup>20</sup>for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.

Col. 4:3,4 And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. <sup>4</sup>Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.

Eph. 5:16 making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.

Col. 4:5 Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity.

Eph. 4:29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

Col. 4:6 Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

Eph. 6:21 Tychicus, the dear brother and faithful servant in the Lord, will tell you everything, so that you also may know how I am and what I am doing.

Col. 4:7 Tychicus will tell you all the news about me. He is a dear brother, a faithful minister and fellow servant<sup>[a]</sup> in the Lord.
